## A Peek at Next Week:

**Phonics:** We are introducing long and short vowels. First, our focus will be on the short vowel sounds of:

Ii – with the sound “i” as in inchworm  
Uu – with the sound “u” as in umbrella

**Sight words:** the, of, and, a

**Math:** Shape/shape names, review and recognition of numbers 0-10, the importance of the number zero (holds no value but holds a place), ABAB patterns

**Social Studies:** Chicka Chicka Boom Boom book, All About Me

**Writing:** Handwriting letters Ii and Uu

**Bible:** The Creation Story
