## A Peek at Next Week:

**Phonics:** Introduce blends and letters:

Nn – na, ne, ni, no, nu

Hh – ha, he, hi, ho, hu

Please review these blends and vowel sounds daily. We are on our way to learning to read. We will move to working with long and short vowels...but currently we are focused on the short vowel sounds.

**Sight words:** with, his, they, I

**Math:** Shape/shape names, review and recognition of numbers 0-20, the importance of the number zero (holds no value but holds a place) “Zero the Hero”, ABAB patterns, counting, THE PENNY (money song)

**Science/Social Studies:** Apples

**Writing:** Handwriting letters Nn and Hh

**Bible:** Young Isaac
