## A Peek at Next Week:

**Phonics:** Introduce Blends and letters:

Yy – ya, ye, yi, yo, yu

Qq – qua, que, qui, quo, qu

**RULE** – "You can't have a q without a u!"

**NEW** → *Special Sounds* – ck in duck

**Spelling Words** – can, fan, man, van, ran, tan

**Sight words:** when, your, can, said

**Math:** Shape/shape names, review and recognition of numbers 0-20, the importance of the number zero (holds no value but holds a place) "Zero the Hero", ABAB patterns, counting to 60, counting by 5's and 10's, the penny, the NICKEL (money song), greater than/less than, tens/ones spots, INTRO TO ADDITION AND CLOCKS TO THE HOUR

**Writing:** Handwriting letters, simple sentences
