A Peek at Next Week:

Phonics: Introduce blends and letters:

Dd – da, de, di, do, du

Cc – ca, ce, ki, co, cu

RULE TO TEACH: “K takes i and e, C takes the other 3”

Sight words: at, be, this, have

Math: Shape/shape names, review and recognition of numbers 0-20, the importance of the number zero (holds no value but holds a place) “Zero the Hero”, ABAB patterns, counting to 50, counting by 5's and 10's, THE PENNY (money song), greater than/less than

Social Studies: Pumpkins

Writing: Handwriting letters Cc and Dd

Bible: Abraham and Isaac
